



## Respect Role Plays

Here are some role plays on the topic of **RESPECT** that you can practice with your students:

- You are in your living room, doing your homework and studying hard for an important test you have tomorrow. Your little sister/brother comes in. He/she has had a hard day and wants to have some fun by blasting some music and dancing around the house. You need it to be quiet so you can study. You argue with your brother/sister. How can you sit in the chair of respect?
- An older student calls you a "dork" and you really want to call him/her a name back. What are you feeling and what can you do instead?
- On the playground, another student steals a ball from you. You get really mad. How can you sit in the chair of respect in this situation? What can you say/do to the other student?
- Your friend came to school seeming really mad today. He/she is scowling and not talking much. When he/she does talk, he/she is saying negative things about other people. What do you think is going on with your friend? How can you find out?
