



## Cooperation Role Plays

Here are some role plays on the topic of *COOPERATION* that you can practice with your students:

- A bunch of students really want to play on the swings but there are only 4 swings. So you all agree to swing until the count of 100, and then let someone else have a turn. You are on the swing, and the others say that your time is up. But you are having so much fun that you want to stay on the swing. What do you do?
- In your classroom, there is one girl who is terrible at sports. She gets picked last for every team. She feels badly, and you would like to be nice to her. You know that sports are not her strong point, but how can you approach her and find out what she *IS* interested in and really good at?
- You are in a work group with 4 other students trying to decide what project to do for science. Everyone has a different idea, and no one wants to do anyone else's idea. What can you do/say to help everyone cooperate?
- Everyone in your classroom is working on their own art projects. There are not enough paint brushes for everyone to have one, and every time you try to get one from someone they say that they are not finished with it yet. You can't move forward with your art project and you are getting very frustrated. How can everyone cooperate?
